FORMAL OFFER OFFENTER OF EMPLOYMENT

Candidates who are offered employment will receive a formal letter of offer by e-mail.



ONBOARDING

After receiving a letter of offer, candidates will provide the following, as required:

- Copy of SIN card or document
- Criminal Record Check and/or Vulnerable Sector Check
- Proof of education (as per posted qualifications)
- Professional license / registration / certification (as per posted qualifications)
- Proof of immunizations
