### THE CITY OF FREDERICTON

It is a friendly, inviting community located along the Wolastoq River. Fredericton offers affordable housing and a cost of living well below the national average. ### THE WORKPLACE

Fredericton's Geriatric Medicine team supports older adults living in the community as well as those in hospital. Our physicians consult on the management of frailty, cognitive disorders, polypharmacy, mobility concerns, and complex comorbidities, reflecting the diverse and evolving needs of our region's aging population.

Outpatient clinics are held at the Woodbridge Centre, a well-equipped facility conveniently located near the hospital. Our physicians also do outreach to local long-term care facilities and may conduct home visits, if desired.

Inpatient consultations take place at the Dr. Everett Chalmers Regional Hospital (DECRH), where a broad range of specialty and subspecialty services are offered. Our Geriatricians play an integral role in supporting the care of older adults across the continuum, including acute care, complex medical patients, rehabilitation, and discharge planning.

Physicians work within a highly collaborative and supportive interdisciplinary environment, with strong engagement from nursing, social work, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, pharmacy, and community partners.

Horizon Health is partnered with Dalhousie University and Fredericton is a teaching site for Family Medicine and specialty residents, as well as medical students in an innovative longitudinal clerkship (LIC) program.

### **THE POSITION**

Join a dynamic and collegial team that supports flexibility and professional growth across clinical care, education, quality improvement, research, and administrative interests. The team values collaboration, shared decision-making, and work-life balance.

The role is primarily consultative, with opportunities to shape program development based on physician interests and regional needs.

### **THE OFFER**

This is a salaried position, with base range \$325,494-\$359,788. Paid benefits include vacation and medical education leave, overhead and administrative support, and extended health benefits.

Participation in the General Internal Medicine on-call service is optional and is remunerated additionally in a fee-for-service model. Our physicians enjoy unparalleled work-life balance.

Additional financial benefits may include:

- A recruitment incentive of \$50,000 for a 2-year return of service.
- Relocation support.
- Annual CME funding.
- Participation in provincial retention programs.

### **YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Provide assessment and management of both new and follow-up outpatients through the Geriatric Medicine Clinic at the Woodbridge Centre.
- Provide inpatient consultations upon request in Fredericton and Oromocto hospitals.
- Provide consultations to local nursing home residents at the request of their primary care provider.
- Provide consultations at home, if desired.
- Collaborate in the care of older adults admitted to the inpatient rehabilitation unit at the DECRH, including attending weekly interdisciplinary team meetings.
- Engage in clinical teaching for resident physicians and medical students. Didactic and small-group teaching opportunities are also available.
- There are numerous opportunities to participate in administrative roles for those who wish.



## YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required.
- Geriatric Medicine specialist (Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or equivalent).
- Must hold a valid license to practice medicine in the Province of New Brunswick.
- A member in good standing with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick and the Atlantic Registry.
- Must have current malpractice insurance from the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) appropriate to the category of practice.
- Bilingualism (French/English) would be considered an asset.
