#### THE WORKPLACE

The Moncton Hospital is one of two hospitals serving the Moncton area and is a Level 2 trauma centre with approximately 380 beds, offering a broad range of specialty and subspecialty services.

The Geriatric Medicine service supports the care of older adults across inpatient units and works closely with Internal Medicine, Neurology, Hospitalist services, Family Medicine, Psychiatry, Rehabilitation, and Allied Health teams. The program provides comprehensive geriatric care for patients with complex medical needs, including frailty, cognitive impairment, polypharmacy, and functional decline.

Physicians practice in a collaborative, interdisciplinary environment with strong support from nursing, social work, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, pharmacy, and community care partners to ensure continuity of care and safe transitions between hospital and community settings.

#### THE POSITION

The position is primarily consultative, supporting inpatient services and complex medical patients, with opportunities to participate in outpatient clinics based on program needs and physician interest. Flexible



scheduling options are available, including part-time and locum arrangements. Call requirements are minimal and shared within the group.

The team values collaboration, flexibility, and work-life balance, and physicians work closely together to accommodate scheduling and vacation requests.

## THE OFFER

Remuneration is a Salaried payment model. Salaried position includes full-time admin support and overhead costs.

Additional financial benefits offered by Horizon Health Network, the Government of New Brunswick, or the New Brunswick Medical Society may include:

- Support care planning focused on functional recovery, cognitive health, medication optimization, and safe discharge planning
- Collaborate closely with interdisciplinary teams and community partners
- Participate in quality improvement initiatives related to seniors' care and patient safety
- Teaching and mentorship opportunities with medical students and residents may be available

## YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required
- Certification (or eligibility for certification) with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Geriatric Medicine
- Eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick
- Proficiency in English; bilingual skills are considered an asset
