THE WORKPLACE

Hospitalist medicine in Moncton is based at **The Moncton Hospital (TMH)**, a 386-bed tertiary and critical care facility within **Horizon Health Network**.

TMH is a Level II Trauma Centre and a major referral hospital serving communities across New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, and northern Nova Scotia. The hospital offers tertiary services including neurosurgery, oncology, neonatal care, and a full complement of major services and subspecialties.

The Department of Family Medicine admits patients not requiring obstetrics, surgical intensive care, or acute psychiatric care. The hospitalist scope of practice includes:

- General Internal Medicine
- Geriatrics
- Well newborn care (optional)

All supported by specialist consultants on site.

As a teaching hospital affiliated with **Dalhousie University**, TMH offers opportunities for teaching family medicine residents and learners, with faculty appointments available for qualified physicians.



The hospitalist team is collaborative, supportive, and team-oriented, working within a multidisciplinary environment focused on quality patient care and efficient resource utilization.

THE POSITION

The Moncton Hospital is seeking Family Physician Hospitalists to expand the Hospitalist Program. Hospitalists provide comprehensive inpatient care to:

- Patients admitted from the Emergency Department
- Patients transferred from specialty services for appropriate family medicine care

The typical model is one inpatient line shared between two physicians working **7 days on / 7 days off**. Key features include:

- Supportive contingency plans to maintain safe patient to physician ratios.
- On-call every other night while on duty
- Mandated on-call stipend
- Fee-for-service billing for call-backs after regular working hours
- Group-based vacation scheduling to maintain coverage

Daily responsibilities include:

- Optimizing admission orders and investigations
- Coordinating multidisciplinary care
- Ensuring timely discharge planning
- Completing electronic documentation and discharge summaries
- Participating in rotating call coverage
- Engaging in hospital quality initiatives and committees

This role offers a balanced inpatient practice with both clinical autonomy and strong peer collaboration.

THE OFFER

- Remuneration based on a sessional rate of **\$152-\$168/hour (8-hour day)**, with performance-based adjustments that may be applied retroactively.
Additional compensation includes:
 - Mandated on-call stipend
 - Fee-for-service billing for after-hours call-backs
 - \$50,000 recruitment incentive with 2-year return of service (pre-approval required through Department of Health)
 - Relocation reimbursement
 - Opportunity for faculty appointment and teaching involvement



- This model offers competitive earning potential with predictable scheduling and built-in time off through the 7-on / 7-off structure.

- Provide comprehensive inpatient medical care
- Maintain efficient documentation and communication with patients and families
- Optimize health care resource utilization
- Participate in call rotation
- Attend required departmental and hospital quality meetings
- Participate in quality improvement and committee work as required
- Support teaching and mentorship of learners where applicable
- Practice in accordance with Horizon policies and professional regulatory standards
