THE WORKPLACE

Obstetrics & Gynecology services in the Fredericton region are primarily delivered at the **Dr. Everett Chalmers Regional Hospital (DECRH)**, a modern regional referral centre providing comprehensive women's health services to the community and surrounding areas. DECRH serves as a regional hospital offering a broad range of specialty and subspecialty services, with strong interdisciplinary support from anesthesia, pediatrics, diagnostic imaging, internal medicine, and surgical services. The Obstetrics & Gynecology program provides full-scope obstetrical care, including management of low-risk and high-risk pregnancies, supported by a **Level III NICU**, with approximately 1400 deliveries a year. Gynecologic services are delivered in a collaborative and supportive environment. Physicians benefit from a collegial team structure, strong nursing and allied health support, and access to teaching opportunities through **Dalhousie Medicine New Brunswick**.

PHYSICIAN Practice Model

Obstetrician/Gynecologists practice primarily at DECRH and work collaboratively within a team-based model that supports continuity of care, shared call coverage, and work-life balance.

Physicians benefit from a highly supportive and collaborative environment among colleagues and allied staff.



Overall, this model supports efficient, high-quality women's health care delivery while fostering a collegial and sustainable practice environment.

THE POSITION

The position includes obstetrical and gynecologic care with on-call responsibilities shared within the group. Flexible scheduling options are available, including part-time and locum opportunities. The team is committed to supporting scheduling flexibility and vacation requests, and values collaboration and mutual support.

THE OFFER

Remuneration is provided through a competitive fee-for-service model.

Additional financial benefits offered by Horizon Health Network, the Government of New Brunswick, or the New Brunswick Medical Society may include:

- A recruitment incentive of **\$50,000** for a 2-year return-of-service commitment
- Relocation expenses reimbursed up to **\$8,000**
- Annual CME funding for registration and travel costs

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide comprehensive obstetrical care, including prenatal, intrapartum, and postpartum services
- Provide gynecologic care, including consultations and surgical procedures
- Participate in shared on-call coverage
- Collaborate with interdisciplinary teams, including anesthesia, pediatrics, nursing staff, and allied health professionals
- Participate in quality improvement and patient safety initiatives
- Teaching and mentorship opportunities with medical students and residents may be available

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required
- Certification (or eligibility for certification) with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Obstetrics & Gynecology
- Eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick
- Proficiency in English; bilingual skills are considered an asset
- FRCS(C) or equivalent is required
