THE WORKPLACE

The Miramichi Regional Hospital is a 160-bed regional hospital offering a full range of primary care and specialty services, including family medicine and hospitalist services, general and orthopedic surgery, internal medicine and intensive care, urology, obstetrics and gynecology, ophthalmology, pediatrics, anesthesiology, and pathology.

The Obstetrics & Gynecology service provides comprehensive women's health care to the region, including obstetrical services and gynecologic care. Physicians work within a supportive, multidisciplinary environment with access to anesthesia, pediatrics, diagnostic imaging, and surgical services. Transfers for higher-acuity or subspecialty care are arranged as needed with regional referral centres.

THE POSITION

The position includes a mix of obstetrical and gynecologic practice with on-call responsibilities shared among the group. Flexible scheduling options are available, including part-time and locum opportunities. The team



values collegiality, mutual support, and work-life balance, and works closely together to accommodate scheduling and vacation requests.

THE OFFER

Remuneration is provided through a competitive fee-for-service model. Physicians typically earn strong incomes while maintaining a balanced lifestyle in a supportive rural practice setting. Additional financial benefits offered by Horizon Health Network, the Government of New Brunswick, or the New Brunswick Medical Society include:

- Provide comprehensive obstetrical care, including prenatal, intrapartum, and postpartum services
- Provide gynecologic care, including consultations and surgical procedures within scope of practice

- Collaborate with interdisciplinary teams, including family physicians, nursing staff, pediatrics, anesthesia, and allied health professionals
- Participate in quality improvement initiatives and patient safety activities
- Teaching and mentorship opportunities with medical students and residents may be available

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required
- Certification (or eligibility for certification) with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Obstetrics & Gynecology
- Eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick
- Proficiency in English; bilingual skills are considered an asset
