THE WORKPLACE

The Moncton Hospital is one of two hospitals in the Moncton area, provided through the two Regional Health Authorities of New Brunswick. The hospital serves as a level 2 trauma centre with 380 beds and a wide range of specialty services. The new Obstetrics & Newborn building opened in May 2025 and includes the obstetrics, neonatology and maternal fetal medicine services with their associated clinics.

The Obstetrics & Gynecology program supports a busy level 3 obstetrical service and full-scope gynecologic care, including surgical services. Physicians work in a collaborative, multidisciplinary environment with access to anesthesia, pediatrics, neonatology, maternal fetal medicine, diagnostic imaging, and other subspecialty supports to ensure high-quality, patient-centered care.



THE POSITION

The Moncton Hospital is actively seeking a **full-time or part-time Obstetrician/Gynecologist** to join a collegial and well-established team.

The position includes a mix of obstetrical care, gynecology, and on-call responsibilities shared within the group. Flexible scheduling options are available, including part-time and locum opportunities. The team values collaboration, mutual support, and work-life balance, and physicians work closely together to accommodate scheduling and vacation requests.

THE OFFER

Remuneration is provided through a competitive fee-for-service model. Physicians typically earn strong incomes with a balanced and shared call schedule.

Additional financial benefits offered by Horizon Health Network, the Government of New Brunswick, or the New Brunswick Medical Society may include:

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide comprehensive obstetrical and gynecologic care, including prenatal, intrapartum, and postpartum services
- Participate in on-call coverage as part of a shared rotation
- Collaborate with interdisciplinary teams, including family physicians, midwives, nursing staff, pediatrics, and anesthesia
- Participate in quality improvement initiatives and patient safety activities
- Teaching and mentorship opportunities may be available for medical students and residents

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required
- Certification (or eligibility for certification) with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Obstetrics & Gynecology
- Eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick
- Proficiency in English; bilingual skills are considered an asset
- ATLS and ACLS certification or completion within 6 months of hiring
- Proficiency in English; bilingual skills are considered an asset
