THE WORKPLACE

The Moncton Hospital is one of two hospitals in the Moncton area, provided through the two Regional Health Authorities of New Brunswick. The hospital serves as a level 2 trauma centre with 380 beds and a wide range of specialty services.

The Emergency Department offers 37 patient rooms for performing evaluations and treatments to approx. 45,000 visits annually. The department is well-supported with 24/7 access to diagnostic imaging, in-house mental health nurses, 4 mobile ultrasound machines, 24/7 respiratory therapist coverage, cast technician coverage, and 24/7 access to virtual neurology and trauma programs.

THE POSITION

The Moncton Hospital Emergency Department (ED) is actively seeking a permanent full-time or part-time Emergency Medicine (EM) physician to complement our group of 20+ full time / part time physicians.



Our department offers 8-8.5-hour shifts/day. Part-time and locum positions can also be arranged. We provide excellent shift flexibility for specific scheduling needs and vacation requests. We are a very collegial group who help each other on shift, at handover time and with scheduling requests.

THE OFFER

Remuneration is based on an average sessional rate of \$293.80/hour. No shadow billing is required. Full-time physicians who take 6 weeks of vacation typically gross \$440,000+ per year. Additional financial benefits offered by the Horizon Health Network, Government of New Brunswick or New Brunswick Medical Society include:

- A recruitment incentive of \$50,000 for a 2-year return of service.
- Relocation expenses reimbursed up to \$8,000.
- CME reimbursements for travel, accommodation etc. of 5200\$/year
- A financial retention program.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support to family physicians with EM experience who wish to pursue a dedicated EM career will be provided. Our experienced staff will provide on-shift guidance, advice for further educational opportunities and assistance in challenging the CCFP(EM) exam.
- Simulation teaching / training education, to strengthen EM skills while collaborating and teaching medical students and FM residents.
- Assistance with attaining faculty appointments with the Department of Emergency Medicine at both Dalhousie and Memorial University

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required
- The following certifications are desired, but not required:
 - Certification with the College of Family Physicians of Canada with added Competency in Emergency Medicine (CCFP-EM)
 - Certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Emergency Medicine (FRCPC-EM)
 - Certification with the American Board of Emergency Medicine (ABEM)
 - Fellowship of the Royal College of Emergency Medicine (FRCEM), or equivalent.
 - A plan to achieve this level of certification within 5 years of hiring is encouraged
- Eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick
- ATLS and ACLS certification or completion within 6 months of hiring
- Proficiency in English; bilingual skills are considered an asset
