THE WORKPLACE

The Department of Pediatrics at **The Moncton Hospital** provides comprehensive pediatric and neonatal care for children and families throughout southeastern New Brunswick.

As a major regional referral centre, The Moncton Hospital offers a broad spectrum of pediatric services in a collaborative, multidisciplinary environment supported by strong allied health and specialist teams.

Services include:

- Pediatric consultation services in Emergency and inpatient units
- Outpatient pediatric clinics

THE POSITION

The Department of Pediatrics is seeking a **full-time Pediatrician** to join its physician team in Moncton.

This opportunity offers:

- Shared call responsibilities within a collaborative department structure (no neonatal ICU call)

Academic and teaching opportunities may also be available through affiliated medical education programs, including involvement with medical students and residents.
