THE WORKPLACE

The **Department of Pediatrics** at **Dr. Everett Chalmers Regional Hospital** provides comprehensive pediatric care for children and families throughout central New Brunswick.

As a regional referral centre, DECRH serves a large and diverse catchment population and offers a collaborative, multidisciplinary pediatric environment with strong specialist and allied health support.

Services include:

The department is supported by skilled nursing staff, child life specialists, respiratory therapy, diagnostic imaging, laboratory services, and strong subspecialty partnerships with tertiary centres throughout Atlantic Canada.
