The group fosters a collegial, team-based environment with strong collaboration between internal medicine specialists, referring physicians, and allied health professionals.

THE POSITION

Horizon Health Network is seeking **permanent full-time or part-time Internal Medicine Physicians** to join the team in the Fredericton region, New Brunswick.

Physicians will participate in a diverse internal medicine practice, managing both acute and chronic conditions across inpatient and outpatient settings. Depending on training and interest, opportunities may exist for involvement in sub-specialties such as cardiology, endocrinology, or nephrology. Scheduling is designed to support work-life balance, with flexibility for vacation requests and individual practice preferences. Locum opportunities may also be available.

The Fredericton team is known for its supportive culture, collaborative workflow, and strong relationships with clinical colleagues.

Given the current workforce within the Department of Internal Medicine, the on-call requirement is limited to approximately twice per month, reflecting an enviably manageable call schedule for our team.
