THE WORKPLACE

Internal Medicine services in **Miramichi, New Brunswick**, are delivered at the **Miramichi Regional Hospital (MRH)**, a full-service regional hospital serving the city of Miramichi and surrounding rural communities.

The Miramichi Regional Hospital is a 160-bed hospital with a full range of primary care and specialty services, including family medicine and hospitalist, general and orthopedic surgery, internal medicine and intensive care, urology, obstetrics and gynecology, ophthalmology, pediatrics, anesthesiology, and pathology.

The Internal Medicine department at MRH provides essential inpatient, outpatient, and emergency care to a diverse patient population. The department offers a broad range of services, including management of acute and chronic conditions such as cardiovascular disease, diabetes, respiratory disorders, and complex multi-system illnesses. Internal Medicine physicians collaborate closely with a variety of clinical programs including emergency medicine, surgery, obstetrics, oncology, and critical care to ensure comprehensive patient care.

The Internal Medicine team at MRH is supported by skilled nursing staff, allied health professionals, and administrative support. The department operates in a collaborative environment, fostering teamwork



among physicians, specialists, and multidisciplinary teams to deliver timely and effective patient care in the regional hospital setting.

THE POSITION

Horizon Health Network is seeking **permanent full-time or part-time Internal Medicine Physicians** to join the team at Miramichi Regional Hospital.

The successful candidate will participate in a diverse internal medicine practice, managing both acute and chronic conditions in inpatient, outpatient, and emergency settings. The role offers flexibility in scheduling, with consideration for vacation requests and individual practice preferences. Opportunities for subspecialty involvement in areas such as critical care, cardiology, nephrology, or geriatrics may be available, depending on the candidate's interests and expertise. Locum opportunities are also available.
