THE WORKPLACE

Internal Medicine services in **Moncton, New Brunswick** are primarily delivered at **The Moncton Hospital (TMH)**, one of the busiest hospitals in Atlantic Canada and a key regional referral centre serving southeastern New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island.

The Internal Medicine department at TMH provides a comprehensive range of diagnostic, therapeutic, and clinical services to support inpatient, outpatient, and emergency care. The department offers expertise in managing a wide variety of conditions, including cardiovascular disease, diabetes, respiratory disorders, and complex multi-system illnesses. Internal Medicine works closely with numerous clinical programs, such as emergency medicine, surgery, cardiology, oncology, critical care, and others to provide integrated, patient-centered care.

The Internal Medicine team at TMH is supported by a skilled group of nurses, allied health professionals, and administrative staff. The department fosters a collaborative environment where physicians work



closely with referring physicians and multidisciplinary teams to ensure timely and effective patient care in a high-volume, fast-paced hospital setting.

THE POSITION
