THE WORKPLACE

Internal Medicine services in Saint John, New Brunswick, are primarily delivered through **Saint John Regional Hospital (SJRH)**, the province's largest tertiary referral and teaching hospital. SJRH provides specialized care to patients from across southern New Brunswick and beyond.

The **Internal Medicine department** at SJRH offers comprehensive care for a broad range of acute and chronic conditions, including cardiovascular disease, diabetes, respiratory disorders, and complex multi-system illnesses. The department collaborates with and is supported by a full range of clinical programs, including cardiac sciences, neurology and the stroke care team, critical care, and the surgical specialties. Outpatient care may be tailored to interests, with opportunities for subspecialty involvement in a wide variety of areas.

Internal Medicine at SJRH is supported by a team of subspecialty-trained physicians, skilled nurses, allied health professionals, and administrative staff. The Dalhousie Medicine New Brunswick campus is situated adjacent to the Saint John Regional Hospital, which also hosts a core Internal Medicine Residency Training



Program. An active and acute Internal Medicine Teaching Unit provides care for Internal Medicine inpatients and a collaborative and supportive learning environment for medical students and residents.

THE POSITION

Horizon Health Network is seeking **permanent full-time Internal Medicine Physicians** to join the Internal Medicine team in Saint John.

Physicians will contribute to a dynamic internal medicine practice, managing both acute and chronic conditions in inpatient and outpatient settings. Opportunities for subspecialty involvement in areas such as cardiology, nephrology, geriatrics, or endocrinology may be available, depending on the physician's training and interests.

The practice model offers flexibility in scheduling, vacation planning, and workload distribution, allowing physicians to tailor their practice to their professional and personal needs.

The Saint John Internal Medicine program provides exposure to a broad range of clinical services and patient populations, offering a stimulating practice environment for physicians who enjoy collaborating with specialists in a teaching hospital setting.

THE OFFER

Remuneration is offered through a competitive salary or fee-for-service model, with the Alternative Funding Plan (AFP) applicable depending on the program. Additional financial and professional benefits are available through Horizon Health Network, the Government of New Brunswick, and the New Brunswick Medical Society may include:

- Recruitment incentive of \$50,000 with a 2-year return of service
- Relocation assistance
- CME funding for professional development, including travel and accommodation
- Participation in provincial retention and incentive programs
