THE CITY OF FREDERICTON

Whether you're a lifelong New Brunswicker or new to Eastern Canada, Fredericton offers an exceptional quality of life. Set along the scenic Saint John River, the province's capital blends urban convenience with small-city charm and is home to about 77,500 residents, with over 122,000 in the metropolitan area. The city is a cultural and educational hub, featuring the University of New Brunswick and St. Thomas University, and has a strong francophone community with French language schools and services at Le Centre communautaire Sainte-Anne. Residents enjoy year-round recreation—water sports, biking, golf, skiing at Crabbe Mountain—as well as a thriving arts scene, major festivals, and attractions such as the Beaverbrook Art Gallery and the Boyce Farmers Market. Fredericton is a dynamic, welcoming place for individuals and families alike.

THE WORKPLACE

The Dr. Everett Chalmers Regional Hospital (DECH) is Fredericton's flagship regional referral centre and a key facility within Horizon Health Network. Located in the heart of New Brunswick's capital, DECH is a modern 315 bed teaching hospital providing a broad range of services, including emergency care, surgical services, maternal and newborn care, intensive care, psychiatry, and specialty clinics. As a teaching partner of Dalhousie University and the University of New Brunswick, DECH supports training in nearly 20 health disciplines, making it an ideal environment for clinical learning, collaboration, and career growth.



THE POSITION

Join a collegial department of 11 anesthesiologists supporting a broad surgical practice, including General Surgery, Vascular, ENT, Orthopedics, Urology, Obstetrics & Gynecology, a Preoperative Clinic, and the Acute Pain Service. The site delivers approximately 1,500 babies each year and is preparing to open brand-new operating room facilities in 2026. Regional anesthesia is fully supported and encouraged as part of comprehensive perioperative pain management.

Call opportunities include 16- or 24-hour shifts with an approximate 1:9 rotation. Elective OR days typically run from 08:00–16:30. The department is highly collaborative and collegial, with strong teamwork between anesthesiologists and surgeons. Leadership opportunities are abundant, and committee involvement is strongly encouraged.

THE OFFER

The remuneration for this opportunity is billed Fee-For-Service, which is a direct compensation between the physician and Medicare New Brunswick. Third party payment models are offered for Department Natural Defence (DND) and WorkSafe NB.

Additionally, physicians are Eligible for a daily Per-Diem Stipend of \$744 for regular work days and post call days.

Additional financial benefits offered by the Horizon Health Network, Government of New Brunswick or New Brunswick Medical Society include:

- A recruitment incentive with a return of service
- Relocation expenses reimbursement
- CME reimbursements per year for registration and travel costs
- Generous CMPA reimbursement (currently 100% of annual dues)

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

In addition to providing clinical anesthesiology services, other duties may be assigned to support the operations of Horizon Health Network, including:

- Teach and mentor medical students, residents, nurses, and allied health learners.
- Attend departmental meetings and participate in committees.
- Collaborate with the interdisciplinary team on patient care and education.
- Adhere to evidence-based practices to ensure high standards of care.
- Participate in departmental on-call coverage.
- Support the mission, values, and strategic goals of the Health Authority.



- Perform other duties as assigned by departmental or hospital leadership.

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- A medical degree is required.
- Certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Anesthesiology or equivalent. For more information, please see below*
- Candidates sitting the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Examination in Anesthesiology will also be considered
- Candidates must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick.
- Candidates must be eligible for an academic appointment from Dalhousie University.
- Proficiency in English is required. Bilingual skills would be considered an asset.
- In accordance with immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal and team-building skills.
- Good attendance and work record.
- Physically able to perform assigned duties.
