THE WORKPLACE

The SJRH is our tertiary academic hospital and regional hub with approximately 400 acute care beds. Saint John is the home of Dalhousie Medicine New Brunswick and Saint John boasts residencies in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, and our unique Integrated FM-EM residency training program.

Practicing Psychiatry in Saint John and the surrounding areas offers a diverse mix of clinical settings, including the acute inpatient psychiatric unit at the Saint John Regional Hospital and longer-term, specialized tertiary care at Centracare, a modern 50-bed psychiatric facility offering rehab, psychogeriatrics, and complex-behaviour services. With additional community mental health and crisis services in the region, psychiatrists can tailor their practice across acute care, rehabilitation, and community-based work—making Saint John a dynamic and well-supported place to practice.



THE POSITION

The Saint John Regional Hospital provides a comprehensive range of psychiatric specialist services including:

- General Adult Psychiatry
- Geriatric Psychiatry
- Addictions and Mental Health
- Forensic Psychiatry
- Child and Youth Psychiatry

Clinical excellence, an interest in teaching the health care professions and a keen interest to work effectively on interdisciplinary teams involving all levels of health care providers are essential attributes in our growing, collegial environment.

THE OFFER

Base salary range \$362,517 - \$440,740 plus fee-for-service billing opportunities. The compensation range was recently renegotiated as part of the Physician Services Agreement (PSA) negotiations. In accordance with the negotiated agreement, compensation rates will increase annually through 2028, with the agreement scheduled for renegotiation in 2029.

This salaried position also includes paid time off (vacation and education leave), health/travel insurance benefits, sick benefits, employer paid contributions to our pension plan.

Successful applicants may be eligible to receive the following:

- Recruitment incentives available with a return of service.
- Moving expense reimbursement is available.
- Provided administrative support and office space.

Additional financial benefits offered by the Horizon Health Network, Government of New Brunswick or New Brunswick Medical Society include:

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

Our ideal candidate will collaborate with other Physicians, Nursing and other Allied medical staff in the following areas:



- Community-based Addiction and Mental Health (AMH) team providing consultations and longitudinal care to patients via in-office, virtual and in-home/LTC visits
- Close collaboration with our outstanding Medicine colleagues including consultations to in-patient units
- ECT Service

All members of our department are expected to provide:

- After-hours and weekend on-call coverage for adults and children, providing care for inpatients and consultation to the emergency department (paid stipend and fee-for-service billing)
- ECT Service
- Clinical supervision of medical students and residents

(Note: These responsibilities are the basic and prime duties associated with this position; other related and allied duties may be assigned from time to time as may be necessary to the operation of Horizon Health Network.)

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- You have a Medical Degree from a recognized medical school and postgraduate studies (residency) in the field of Psychiatry.
- You have experience in collaborative multidisciplinary Addiction and Mental Health care.
- You have Certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and a valid license through New Brunswick College of Physicians and Surgeons of New Brunswick (CPSNB) and become a member of the NB Medical Society.
